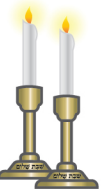

## **Blessing over Wives (Proverbs 31 edited)**

May God make you good husbands, wives, fathers and mothers. May the Lord protect you and defend you, May His spirit fill you with grace, May our family grow in happiness, O hear our Sabbath prayer.
